**Course description:** This course is designed to give the participant awareness on how to manage dental issues holistically in a clinical setting utilizing Traditional Osteopathic principles. Osteopaths and dentists have been working together for many years as they realize the impact that both dental procedures and materials can have on the patient. Conventional dentists have no awareness of this and it is only the biological dentist who treats the mouth as a continuum with the rest of the patient. Similarly, Osteopathy was designed to function in the same way. The Osteopath must not only historically address dental considerations in reference to the patient’s presentation, but they must also be able to recognize the physical and metabolic issues that present in the patient. We will address these clinical issues and how to approach them in an efficient and effective way. There will be in-depth lectures on the anatomy of the face, dural sac and its connections to the whole. In addition, understanding the effects in the fluid and potency is crucial in both diagnosis and treatment; both will be discussed in detail. The midline and the effects of the structure and function around it related to dental work will be addressed as well. Finally, we aim to bring this course together utilizing the whole and its still fulcrum as a way to both rebalance and integrate.

***Participants must be a licensed DO, MD, DDS, or DMD and have successfully completed at least one basic, 40 hour course in Osteopathy in the Cranial Field (OCA or SCTF) and one Biodynamics of Osteopathy course (or equivalent as determined by the course director).
