<b>Project Design/Strategy:</b> <i>Describes the team's analytic approach to determining a solution to implement</i>	1: Not Addressed 2: Unclear (Lists selection of solution by team without further clarification) 3: Meets (Describes methods used by team to determine most appropriate solution) 4: Exceeds (Provides factual details on the analytic process for selecting the solution(s) to implement)	
<b>Changes Made:</b> <i>Describes the procedure, system, or other changes that were made to implement the solution(s)</i>	1: Not Addressed 2: Unclear (Limited coverage of changes made) 3: Meets (Describes the procedures, systems, or other changes made) 4: Exceeds (Explains how procedures, systems, or other changes were made and evaluated)	
<b>Outcomes &amp; Lessons Learned:</b> <i>Describes the project's outcome measures</i>	1: Not Addressed 2: Unclear (Describes outcomes anticipated from the project without clearly defining how outcomes or process changes were measured) 3: Meets (Provides clear description of measures used to determine impact of the project on the outcome intended) 4: Exceeds (Describes why the operational measures used to determine impact of the project were chosen)	
<b>Next Steps</b>	1: Not Addressed 2: Unclear (Describes outcomes from the project without clearly defining future related activities) 3: Meets (Describes of outcomes with clearly defined related future activities) 4: Exceeds (Describes outcomes of project with clearly defined related future activities and strategy for diffusion of change)	
<b>References Acknowledgements</b>	1. Not Addressed 2. Incompletely addressed 3. Fully addressed	
<b>Overall organization, content, and presentation of the project</b>	1: Unclear (Poster is unorganized, information is unclear) 2: Meets (Information is arranged logically and project description is clearly presented) 3: Exceeds (The project is well covered, logically presented, and artistic elements enhance the presentation)
